<b>1.SCRAP (VERB): (फेंक देना): throw away</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> throw out, get rid of
<b>Antonyms:</b> keep
<b>Example Sentence:</b> A bold decision was taken to scrap existing plant
<b>.2.NOTABLE (ADJECTIVE): (उल्लेखनीय): noteworthy</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> remarkable, outstanding
<b>Antonyms:</b> insignificant
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The gardens are notable for their collection of magnolias and camellias.
<b>3.SCRUTINY (NOUN): (जांच): inspection</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> survey, scan
<b>Antonyms:</b> glance
<b>Example Sentence:</b> She checked her weapons with scrutiny that would've made her father proud.
<b>4. SCANTY (ADJECTIVE): (अल्प): meagre</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> scant, minimal
<b>Antonyms:</b> abundant
<b>Example Sentence:</b> They paid whatever they could out of their scanty wages to their families.
<b>5. ABROGATION (NOUN): (निराकरण): repudiation</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> revocation, repeal
<b>Antonyms:</b> institution
<b>Example Sentence:</b> They have regarded the law's renewal and abrogation with about equal anxiety.
<b>6. GRIEVANCE (NOUN): (शिकायत): complaint</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> criticism, objection

<b>Antonyms:</b> commendation
<b>Example Sentence:</b> He was nursing a grievance.
<b>7.FLIMSY (ADJECTIVE): (असाध्य): insubstantial</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> slight, light
<b>Antonyms:</b> sturdy
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The huts are relatively few and flimsy.
<b>8.EVENTFUL (ADJECTIVE): (ब्यस्त): busy</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> event-filled, action-packed
<b>Antonyms:</b> dull
<b>Example Sentence:</b> His long and eventful life.
<b>9.SKETCHY (ADJECTIVE): (अधूरा): incomplete</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> inadequate, limited
<b>Antonyms:</b> detailed
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The information they had was sketchy.
<b>10.EMBARRASSMENT (NOUN): (शर्मिंदगी): awkwardness</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> self-consciousness, unease
<b>Antonyms:</b> confidence
<b>Example Sentence:</b> I turned red with embarrassment.
