

VOCABULARY FOR 6 FEBRUARY 2024

1. INEVITABLY (ADVERB): (अनिवार्य रूप से): unavoidably

Synonyms: automatically, necessarily

Antonyms: avoidably

Example Sentence: Inevitably some details are already out of date.

2. FRAUGHT (ADJECTIVE): (बेचैन): anxious

Synonyms: worried, upset

Antonyms: calm

Example Sentence: There was a fraught silence in the cabin.

3. INCENDIARY (ADJECTIVE): (उत्तेजक): inflammatory

Synonyms: provocative, agitational

Antonyms: conciliatory

Example Sentence: The principal's incendiary remarks were not appropriate for the students to hear.

4. STARTLE (VERB): (डराना): surprise

Synonyms: frighten, scare

Antonyms: put at ease

Example Sentence: A sudden sound in the doorway startled all of us.

5. SAGACIOUS (ADJECTIVE): (बुद्धिमान): wise

Synonyms: clever, intelligent

Antonyms: stupid

Example Sentence:

Step by step, with sagacious attitude, he advanced to the great discovery.

6. DISRUPT (VERB): (भंग करना): distort

Synonyms: damage, buckle

Antonyms: organize

Example Sentence: It wasn't like Alex to let anger disrupt his schedule.

7. VENOMOUS (ADJECTIVE): (द्वेषपूर्ण): vicious

Synonyms: spiteful, rancorous

Antonyms: friendly

Example Sentence: She replied with a venomous glance.

8. LEGITIMATE (ADJECTIVE): (वैध): valid

Synonyms: sound, admissible

Antonyms: invalid

Example Sentence: His excuse for being late was legitimate.

9. INADVERTENTLY (ADVERB): (अनजाने में): accidentally

Synonyms: by accident, unintentionally

Antonyms: deliberately

Example Sentence: His name had been inadvertently omitted from the list.

10. SLASH (VERB): (कम करना): reduce

Synonyms: cut drop

Antonyms: raise

Example Sentence: The workforce has been slashed by 3,000.
