Antonyms: support

Example Sentence: The flow of water had undermined pillars supporting the roof

.8.STRIDENT (ADJECTIVE): (कठोर): harsh

Synonyms: raucous, rough

Antonyms: soft

Example Sentence: His voice had become increasingly strident.

9.CREST (NOUN): (शिखर): summit

Synonyms: peak, top

Antonyms: bottom

Example Sentence:She reached the crest of the hill

10.INTERIM (अन्तरिम): interim (ADJECTIVE):

Synonyms: temporary, pro tem

Antonyms: permanent

Example Sentence: Interim booking has been made for now.
