<b>1.UNFOUNDED</b> (ADJECTIVE): (निराधार): groundless
<b>Synonyms:</b> baseless, unsubstantiated
<b>Antonyms:</b> well founded
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Her fear that she had cancer was unfounded.
<b>2.BAFFLE</b> (VERB): (विस्मित करना): bewilder
<b>Synonyms:</b> mystify, bemuse
<b>Antonyms:</b> enlighten
<b>Example Sentence:</b> She was baffled by his sudden change of mood.
<b>3.DURABLE</b> (ADJECTIVE): (टिकाऊ): long-lasting
<b>Synonyms:</b> hard-wearing, heavy-duty
<b>Antonyms:</b> flimsy
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Porcelain enamel is strong and durable.
<b>4.CONSTRAINT</b> (NOUN): (प्रतिबंध): inhibition
<b>Synonyms:</b> uneasiness, embarrassment
<b>Antonyms:</b> openness
<b>Example Sentence:</b> They would be able to talk without constraint.
<b>5.IMPLICATE</b> (NOUN): (दोषी ठहराना): incriminate
<b>Synonyms:</b> compromise, involve
<b>Antonyms:</b> absolve
<b>Example Sentence:</b> He was implicated in a price-fixing scandal.
<b>6.FORGO</b> (VERB): (त्यागना): do without
<b>Synonyms:</b> go without, give up
<b>Antonyms:</b> keep

**Example Sentence:**He wanted to forgo the tea and leave while they could.

**7.UNWAVERING** (ADJECTIVE): (स्थिर): steady

**Synonyms:** fixed resolute

**Antonyms:** unsteady

**Example Sentence:**She fixed him with an unwavering stare.

**8.CONFIDENTIAL** (ADJECTIVE): (गुप्त): private

**Synonyms:** personal, intimate

**Antonyms:** public, on record

**Example Sentence:**His confidential information got leaked.

**9.APEX** (ADJECTIVE): (शिखर): tip

**Synonyms:** peak, crest

**Antonyms:** bottom

**Example Sentence:**We reached the apex of the roof.
