4.OBLIVIOUS (ADJECTIVE):

Synonyms: unconscious, heedless

Antonyms: aware

oblivious to the passage of time.

5.PROPORTIONAL (ADJECTIVE):

(आनुपातिक): corresponding

Synonyms: proportionate, comparable

Antonyms: disproportionate

Example Sentence: The punishment should

be proportional to the crime.

6.APPREHENSION (NOUN):

(चिंता): anxiety

Synonyms: angst, alarm

Antonyms: confidence

Example Sentence:He felt with sick

apprehension.

7.AMITY (NOUN): (मित्रता): friendship

Synonyms: friendliness, peace

Antonyms: animosity

Example Sentence: The presence French troops in Scotland had produced

hostility rather than amity.

8.STRIFE (NOUN): (कलह): conflict

Synonyms: friction, discord

Antonyms: harmony

Example Sentence: With the civil strife, the importance and prosperity of the ruling party

declined.

9.BUCK (VERB): (विरोध करना): resist

Synonyms: oppose contradict

Antonyms: give in, accept

Example Sentence: The shares bucked the

market trend.

10.CAPSIZE (VERB): (पलटना): turn over

Synonyms: turn over, upset

Antonyms: right

Example Sentence: The craft capsized in

heavy seas.
