

VOCABULARY FOR 26 APRIL 2024

1. ZEALOUS (ADJECTIVE):
(उत्साही): fervent

Synonyms: ardent, fervid

Antonyms: apathetic

Example Sentence:The council was extremely zealous in the application of the regulations.

2. APPEALING (ADJECTIVE):
(आकर्षक): attractive

Synonyms: engaging, alluring

Antonyms: off-putting

Example Sentence:Village life is somehow more appealing than city's.

3. HOSTILITY (NOUN): (युद्ध): fighting

Synonyms: conflict, combat

Antonyms: peace

Example Sentence:He called for an immediate cessation of hostilities.

4. RELATIVE (ADJECTIVE):
(तुलनात्मक): comparative

Synonyms: respective, comparable

Antonyms: absolute

Example Sentence:The relative effectiveness of the various mechanisms is not known.

5. AGITATE (VERB): (उत्तेजित करना): upset

Synonyms: perturb, fluster

Antonyms: calm

Example Sentence:The thought of questioning Tony agitated him extremely.

6. CAPTIVATE (VERB): (मोह लेना): enthrall

Synonyms: charm, enchant

Antonyms: repel

Example Sentence:He was captivated by her beauty.

7. ABANDONED (ADJECTIVE):
(असंयत): uninhibited

Synonyms: reckless, unrestrained

Antonyms: restrained

Example Sentence:He performed a wild, abandoned dance.

8. BUTTRESS (VERB): (समर्थन देना): strengthen

Synonyms: reinforce, fortify

Antonyms: weaken

Example Sentence:He buttressed his idea by religious belief.

9. PROMINENT (ADJECTIVE):
(अगोचर): conspicuous

Synonyms: noticeable, obvious

Antonyms: inconspicuous

Example Sentence:The new housing estates are prominent landmarks.

10. DETENTION (NOUN): (कैद): custody

Synonyms: imprisonment, confinement

Antonyms: relinquishment

Example Sentence:The fifteen people arrested were still in police detention.
