PARTLY (ADVERB):** (आंशिक रूप में): **in part****Synonyms:** partially, somewhat**Antonyms:** completely**Example Sentence:** The result is partly a matter of skill and partly of chance.**4. FRAUDULENT (ADJECTIVE):** (कपटपूर्ण): **dishonest****Synonyms:** cheating, swindling**Antonyms:** honest**Example Sentence:** I wouldn't dream of going into business with that fraudulent insurance company**5. UNDERMINE (VERB):** (दुर्बल करना): **erode****Synonyms:** wear away, undercut**Antonyms:** support**Example Sentence:** The flow of water had undermined pillars supporting the roof.**6. REVOKE (VERB):** (रद्द करना): **cancel****Synonyms:** repeal, rescind**Antonyms:** introduce**Example Sentence:** The men appealed and the sentence was revoked.**7. SPECIFIC (ADJECTIVE):** (सटीक): **exact****Synonyms:** accurate, precise**Antonyms:** vague**Example Sentence:** When ordering goods, be specific.**8 AGITATION (NOUN):** (आवेश): **anxiety****Synonyms:** perturbation, disquiet**Antonyms:** calmness**Example Sentence:** She was wringing her hands in agitation.**9 BYGONE (ADJECTIVE):** (पुराना): **ancient****Synonyms:** past, former**Antonyms:** contemporary**Example Sentence:** That is contrary to the observation of philosophers of bygone days.**10. STIMULATE (VERB):** (प्रेरित करना): **encourage****Synonyms:** prompt, prod**Antonyms:** discourage**Example Sentence:** The reader could not fail to be stimulated by the ideas presented.
