**Synonyms:** marry, couple

**Antonyms:** split

**Example** Sentence:

He allied his racing experience with his

father's business acumen.

5. RENUNCIATION (NOUN):

(निवृत्ति): abandonment

**Synonyms:** resignation, abdication

**Antonyms:** assertion

**Example Sentence:** The talks were dependent on a renunciation of

terrorism.

6. STRATEGIC (ADJECTIVE):

(योजनाबद्ध): planned

Synonyms: calculated, deliberate

Antonyms: random

**Example Sentence:** His own strategic plan, which could not be carried out

now, was forgotten.

7. MITIGATE (VERB): (कम

करना): alleviate

Synonyms: reduce, diminish

**Antonyms:** aggravate

**Example Sentence:** Drainage schemes

have helped to mitigate this problem

.8. INTACT (ADJECTIVE):

(अक्षुण्ण): whole

Synonyms: entire, complete

**Antonyms:** broken

Example Sentence: Only the medieval

tower had remained intact.

9. WAIVE (VERB): (छोड़ देना): disregard

Synonyms: ignore, overlook

Antonyms: uphold

Example Sentence: He didn't waive his

right in the matter.

10. SWIFTLY (ADVERB): (तेजी से): fast

Synonyms: quickly, rapidly

Antonyms: slowly

Example Sentence: He got up and

walked swiftly to the door.
