ALLIANCE (NOUN): (संबंध): relationship****Synonyms:** affinity, association**Antonyms:** distance**Example Sentence:** A balanced alliance between traditions and modernity avoids chaos.**4. ALLY (VERB): (संघटित करना): combine****Synonyms:** marry, couple**Antonyms:** split**Example Sentence:** He allied his racing experience with his father's business acumen.**5. RENUNCIATION (NOUN): (निवृत्ति): abandonment****Synonyms:** resignation, abdication**Antonyms:** assertion**Example Sentence:** The talks were dependent on a renunciation of terrorism.**6.
