<b>1.CONTEMPLATIVE (ADJECTIVE):</b> (विचारशील): thoughtful
<b>Synonyms:</b> pensive, reflective
<b>Antonyms:</b> active
<b>Example Sentence:</b> She regarded me with a contemplative eye.
<b>2.CAPACIOUS (ADJECTIVE):</b> (लंबा-चौड़ा): roomy
<b>Synonyms:</b> commodious, spacious
<b>Antonyms:</b> cramped
<b>Example Sentence:</b> She looked for a hairpin in her capacious handbag.
<b>3.ADUMBRATE (VERB):</b> (पूर्वाभास देना): foreshadow
<b>Synonyms:</b> outline, darken
<b>Antonym:</b> illuminate, light up
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The setting sun adumbrates the bridge to create a scenic view.
<b>4.IMMORAL (ADJECTIVE):</b> (अनैतिक): unethical
<b>Synonyms:</b> bad, wrongful
<b>Antonyms:</b> moral
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Her behaviour was seemingly immoral.
<b>5.INQUISITIVE (ADJECTIVE):</b> (जिज्ञासु): curious
<b>Synonyms:</b> intrigued, interested
<b>Antonyms:</b> uninterested
<b>Example Sentence:</b> I didn't like to seem inquisitive.
<b>6. ASSAULT (VERB):</b> (हमला करना): hit
<b>Synonyms:</b> strike, smack
<b>Antonyms:</b> defend

<b>Example Sentence:</b> He pleaded guilty to assaulting a police officer.
<b>7.CONTEMPT (NOUN):</b> (निंदा): scorn
<b>Synonyms:</b> disregard, disrespect
<b>Antonyms:</b> respect
<b>Example Sentence:</b> She treated everyone with much contempt.
<b>8.RESOLVE (NOUN):</b> (दृढ़ निश्चय): determination
<b>Synonyms:</b> resolution, purpose
<b>Antonyms:</b> indecision
<b>Example Sentence:</b> She received information which had strengthened her resolve.
<b>9.WHIP (VERB):</b> (पीटना): bash
<b>Synonyms:</b> beat, lash
<b>Antonyms:</b> compliment, praise
<b>Example Sentence:</b> He was whipped badly.
<b>10.CONTINUAL (ADJECTIVE):</b> (लगातार): ceaseless
<b>Synonyms:</b> continuous, enduring
<b>Antonyms:</b> finished, end
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Your words are the source of continual inspiration.
