1. INDULGE (NOUN): (लिप्त होना): Give oneself up to
Synonyms: Give way to
Antonyms: Stifle
Example Sentence: At a time the crown prince was able to indulge to the full his personal tastes.
2. MERE (ADJECTIVE): (एकमात्र): Trifling
Synonyms: Meagre, Bare
Antonyms: Important
Example Sentence: Many questions cannot be answered by mere mortals.
3. ENTERTAIN (VERB): (ध्यान रखना): Consider
Synonyms: Take into consideration
Antonyms: Reject
Example Sentence: Washington entertained little hope of an early improvement in relations.
4. CONUNDRUM (NOUN): (मुसीबत): Problem
Synonyms: Difficulty, Quandary
Antonyms: Answer
Example Sentence: It was one of the most difficult conundrums for the experts.
5. INADEQUATE (ADJECTIVE): (अपर्याप्त): Insufficient
Synonyms: Deficient, Scant
Antonyms: Adequate
Example Sentence: These labels prove to be wholly inadequate.
6. HERD (VERB): (देखभाल करना): Look after
Synonyms: Take care of, Keep

Antonyms: Neglect
Example Sentence: They live by herding reindeer.
7. PROGRESSIVE (ADJECTIVE): (प्रगतिशील): Modern
Synonyms: Liberal, Advanced
Antonyms: Conservative
Example Sentence: He owns the most progressive art school.
8. HAVOC (NOUN): (अव्यवस्था): Disorder
Synonyms: Chaos, Disruption
Antonyms: Peace
Example Sentence: If they weren't at school they'd be wreaking havoc in the streets.
9. PEAK (ADJECTIVE): (अधिकतम): Maximum
Synonyms: Maximal, Top
Antonyms: Minimum
Example Sentence: The canal was restored to peak condition.
10. FLOUT (VERB): (अवज्ञा करना): Defy
Synonyms: Go against, scorn
Antonyms: Observe
Example Sentence: The advertising code is being flouted.
