1. DELIBERATE (ADJECTIVE):
(सुविचार): Intentional

Synonyms: Calculated, Conscious

Antonyms: Accidental

Example Sentence: A deliberate attempt was made to provoke conflict.

2. ACCOUNTABILITY (NOUN):
(जवाबदेही): Responsibility

Synonyms: Liability, Answerability

Antonyms: Irresponsibility

Example Sentence: Lack of accountability has corroded public respect for political leaders.

3. DENY (VERB): (अस्वीकार करना): Refuse

Synonyms: Turn down, Reject

Antonyms: Accept

Example Sentence: The inquiry was denied access to intelligence sources

4. EXCAVATION (NOUN):
(उत्खनन): Unearthing

Synonyms: Uncovering, Revealing

Antonyms: Bury

Example Sentence: The methods of excavation have to be extremely rigorous

5. SUSTAINABLE (ADJECTIVE):
(सतत): Continual

Synonyms: Continuous, Viable

Antonyms: Unsustainable

Example Sentence: Economic growth must be gradual and sustainable.

6. SPUR (NOUN): (प्रोत्साहन): Stimulus

Synonyms: Incentive, Encouragement

Antonyms: Disincentive

Example Sentence: Wars act as a spur to practical invention.

7. IMMINENT (ADJECTIVE):
(समुपस्थित): Impending

Synonyms: At hand, Close

Antonyms: Remote

Example Sentence: They were in imminent danger of being swept away.

8. EMINENT (ADJECTIVE):
(प्रख्यात): Illustrious

Synonyms: Distinguished, Renowned

Antonyms: Unknown

Example Sentence: He is one of the world's most eminent scientists.

9. EXTRAORDINARY (ADJECTIVE):
(असाधारण): Remarkable

Synonyms: Exceptional, Amazing

Antonyms: Ordinary

Example Sentence:The sight of thousands of flamingoes flying in the sky was extraordinary.

10. INTIMACY (NOUN):
(घनिष्ठता): Closeness

Synonyms: Togetherness. Affinity

Antonyms: Being Unfriendly

Example Sentence:The intimacy of these two is evident to all.
