1.DIRECTIVE (NOUN):(निदेशात्मक): instruction
Synonyms: direction, command
Antonyms: lawlessness
Example Sentence: A new EC directive has been forwarded for approval.
2.CONSENSUS (NOUN): (सहमति): agreement
Synonyms: harmony, concord
Antonyms: disagreement
Example Sentence: There is a growing consensus that the current regime has failed.
3.PALLIATIVE(ADJECTIVE):(पीड़ाहटानेवाला): soothing
Synonyms: alleviating sedative
Antonyms: intensifying
Example Sentence: Travel is like a palliative against depression for him.
4.CONVALESCENT (ADJECTIVE): (अच्छा हो जानेवाला): recuperating
Synonyms: recovering improving
Antonyms: faltering
Example Sentence: He has always been a convalescent child.
5. RESUMPTION (NOUN): (पुनरारंभ): restart
Synonyms: recommencement, reopening
Antonyms: suspension
Example Sentence: With peace came the resumption of foreign imports.
6. EXTREMIST (NOUN): (अतिवादी): fanatic

Synonyms: radical, zealot
Antonyms: moderate
Example Sentence: Right-wing extremists created trouble.
7.SCEPTICISM (NOUN): (संदेहवाद): doubt
Synonyms: disbelief, distrust
Antonyms: conviction
Example Sentence: There was some scepticism in the claims
.8.DISASTROUS(ADJECTIVE):(उत्पातक): catastrophic
Synonyms: calamitous, cataclysmic
Antonyms: fortunate
Example Sentence: A disastrous fire swept through the museum
.9.DISCRIMINATION (NOUN):(भेदभाव): prejudice
Synonyms: bias, bigotry
Antonyms: impartiality
Example Sentence: They are victims of racial discrimination.
10.CURB (VERB): (नियंत्रण करना): restrain
Synonyms: hold back, keep back
Antonyms: release
Example Sentence: She promised she would curb her temper.
