

VOCABULARY FOR 12 JUNE 2024

1. ENTANGLE (VERB): (उलझाना): Intertwine
Synonyms: Entwine, Tangle
Antonyms: Disentangle
Example Sentence: Fish attempt to swim through the mesh and become entangled.
2. SEGREGATION (NOUN): (अलगाव): Separation
Synonyms: Setting apart, Isolation
Antonyms: Integration
Example Sentence: The segregation of pupils with learning difficulties was done.
3. AFFORDABLE (ADJECTIVE): (किफायती): Inexpensive
Synonyms: Reasonably Priced
Antonyms: Unaffordable
Example Sentence: Homes have become affordable now and is no more a luxury.
4. ACCIDENTAL (ADJECTIVE): (आकस्मिक): Fortuitous
Synonyms: Chance, Adventitious
Antonyms: Intentional
Example Sentence: Land might be let at a fixed rent but accidental loss falls on the tenant.
5. ROUGHLY (ADVERB): (लगभग): Approximately
Synonyms: About, Around
Antonyms: Exactly
Example Sentence: We all took a walk of roughly 13 miles from our hotel.
6. PREDATORY (ADJECTIVE): (हिंसक): Predacious
Synonyms: Carnivorous, Hunting
Antonyms: Defensive
Example Sentence: Species of shark are usually predatory.

7. EXACERBATE (VERB): (खराब करना): Worsen
Synonyms: Aggravate, Compound
Antonyms: Improve
Example Sentence: Her condition exacerbated on the flight.
8. RETRACT (VERB): (वापस लेना): Pull in
Synonyms: Draw in, Pull back
Antonyms: Extend
Example Sentence: She retracted her hand as if she'd been burnt.
9. REFORM (VERB): (सुधारना): Improve
Synonyms: Better, Refine
Antonyms: Preserve
Example Sentence: The Bill will reform the tax system.
10. CRITICAL (ADJECTIVE): (अवरोधक): Censorious
Synonyms: Condemnatory, Condemning
Antonyms: Complimentary
Example Sentence: I was very critical of the previous regime.
