1. CONJECTURE (NOUN):
(अनुमान): Speculation

Synonyms: Guess Surmise

Antonyms: Fact

Example Sentence:Conjectures about the newcomer were many and varied.

2. FURNISH (VERB): (प्रदान करना): Provide

Synonyms: Supply, Equip

Antonyms: Divest

Example Sentence:Fish furnish an important source of protein.

3. TRANSIT (NOUN): (पारवहन): Movement

Synonyms: Transport, Transportation

Antonyms: Hold, Stagnation

Example Sentence:A painting was damaged in transit.

4. REFRAIN (VERB): (बचना): Abstain

Synonyms: Desist, Hold back

Antonyms: Indulge, Venture

Example Sentence:She refrained from comment.

5. COMPREHENSIVE (ADJECTIVE): (व्यापक): Inclusive

Synonyms: Complete, Thorough

Antonyms: Partial, Selective

Example Sentence:He showed me a comprehensive collection of photographs.

6. SPURT (VERB): (उछलना): Shoot

Synonyms: Squirt, Spray

Antonyms: Contain

Example Sentence:He cut his finger, and blood spurted over the sliced potatoes.

7. BRUNT (ADJECTIVE): (आघात): Impact

Synonyms: Force, Shock

Antonyms: Resistance, Endurance

Example Sentence:Education will bear the brunt of the cuts.

8. STULTIFY (VERB): (उबा देना): Bore

Synonyms: Stupefy Weary

Antonyms: Interest, Entertain

Example Sentence:She is too polite to bore us with anecdotes.

9 APPEASE (VERB): (तुष्ट करना): Pacify

Synonyms: Conciliate, Placate

Antonyms: Provoke, Inflame

Example Sentence:Amendments have been added to appease local pressure groups.

10. HOARD (VERB): (संचय करना): Store

Synonyms: Cache, Stockpile

Antonyms: Squander

Example Sentence:He came back to rescue his little hoard of gold.
