**1. FISHY (ADJECTIVE):**  
(संदेहजनक): Dubious

**Synonyms:** Doubtful, Suspicious

**Antonyms:** Truthful, Aboveboard

**Example Sentence:** I am convinced there is something fishy going on.

**2. SCRAMBLE (VERB):** (अव्यवस्थित करना): Disarrange

**Synonyms:** Muddle, Confuse

**Antonyms:** Organize, Align

**Example Sentence:** Maybe the alcohol scrambled his brains.

**3. KNAVE (NOUN):** (दुष्ट): Fraud

**Synonyms:** Miscreant, Rogue

**Antonyms:** Hero, Angel

**Example Sentence:** He is known as a notorious knave of this area.

**4. LUDICROUS (ADJECTIVE):** (ऊटपटांग): Absurd

**Synonyms:** Bizarre, Comical

**Antonyms:** Normal, Ordinary

**Example Sentence:** It was a ludicrous statement made by her.

**5. KUDOS (NOUN):** (प्रशंसा): Praise

**Synonyms:** Esteem, Applause

**Antonyms:** Dishonour, Denunciation

**Example Sentence:** When the football team won the state championship, they were given kudos during a celebratory pep rally.

**6. CONSENT (NOUN):** (सहमति): Assent

**Synonyms:** Agreement, Permission

**Antonyms:** Dissent, Disagreement

**Example Sentence:** Change was made without the consent.

**7. CULMINATION (NOUN):**  
(परिणति): Climax

**Synonyms:** Peak, Pinnacle

**Antonyms:** Nadir

**Example Sentence:** The deal marked the culmination of years of negotiation.

**8. AIDE (NOUN):** (सहयोगी): Assistant

**Synonyms:** Helper, Adviser

**Antonyms:** Boss

**Example Sentence:** The presidential aide was just 23.

**9. CODIFY (VERB):** (संहिताबद्ध करना): Organize

**Synonyms:** Systematize, Arrange

**Antonyms:** Expunge, Abrogate

**Example Sentence:** The statutes have codified certain branches of common law.

**10. SHUN (VERB):** (टालना): Avoid

**Synonyms:** Evade, Eshew

**Antonyms:** Accept, Welcome

**Example Sentence:** He shunned fashionable society.
