1. CONVENTIONAL (ADJECTIVE):
(पारंपरिक): Normal

Synonyms: Standard, Regular

Antonyms: original

Example Sentence: A conventional morality had dictated behaviour.

2. ALLUDE (VERB): (संकेत करना): Suggest

Synonyms: Imply, Mention

Antonyms: Specify

Example Sentence: Mrs. Sharma alluded to some health problems, without being specific.

3. INDUCE (VERB): (उत्प्रेरित करना): Persuade

Synonyms: Convince, Get

Antonyms: Dissuade

Example Sentence: The pickets induced many workers to stay away.

4. INDUCT (VERB): (प्रतिष्ठित करना): Admit to

Synonyms: Allow into, Introduce to

Antonyms: Bar from

Example Sentence: Arrangements have been made to induct new members to the organization.

5. ACCESSIBLE (ADJECTIVE):
(सुगम): Approachable

Synonyms: Available, Easy-going

Antonyms: unapproachable

Example Sentence: He is more accessible than most tycoons.

6. CONTENT (ADJECTIVE):
(संतुष्ट): contented

Synonyms: satisfied, pleased

Antonyms: discontented

Example Sentence: He seemed more content, less bitter.

7. INEQUALITY (NOUN):
(असमानता): Imbalance

Synonyms: Inequity, Disproportion

Antonyms: Equity

Example Sentence: Social inequality is now on its peak.

8. INTEGRITY (NOUN): (अखंडता): Unity

Synonyms: Unification, Wholeness

Antonyms: Division

Example Sentence: The PM upholds territorial integrity and national sovereignty.

9. BRUTAL (ADJECTIVE): (क्रूर): Savage

Synonyms: Cruel, Bloodthirsty

Antonyms: Gentle

Example Sentence: He was accused of a brutal murder.

10. SENSELESS (ADJECTIVE):
(बेहोश): Pointless

Synonyms: Futile, Hopeless

Antonyms: Sensible

Example Sentence: It was as senseless as crossing Death Valley on foot.
