<b>1. FEASIBLE (ADJECTIVE):</b> (व्यवहार्य): Practicable
<b>Synonyms:</b> Practical, Workable
<b>Antonyms:</b> Impractical
<b>Example Sentence:</b> It is not feasible to put most finds from excavations on public display.
<b>2. COMPROMISE (NOUN):</b> (समझौता): Agreement
<b>Synonyms:</b> Understanding, Settlement
<b>Antonyms:</b> Intransigence
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Eventually they reached a compromise.
<b>3. FEDERAL (ADJECTIVE):</b> (संयुक्त): Confederate
<b>Synonyms:</b> Federated, Combined
<b>Antonyms:</b> Unitary
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The health ministry has sole federal responsibility for healthcare.
<b>4. RETRIBUTION (NOUN):</b> (प्रतिदण्ड): Punishment
<b>Synonyms:</b> Penalty, Nemesis
<b>Antonyms:</b> Forgiveness
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Employees asked not to be named, saying they feared retribution.
<b>5. VIABLE (ADJECTIVE):</b> (व्यवहार्य): Workable
<b>Synonyms:</b> Feasible, Practicable
<b>Antonyms:</b> Impracticable
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The proposed investment was said to be economically viable.
<b>6. INSURGENT (NOUN): (विद्रोही): Rebel</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> Revolutionary, Mutineer
<b>Antonyms:</b> Loyalist

**Example Sentence:** The armed insurgents planned an attack.

**7. DECIMATE (VERB): (बरबाद करना): Destroy**

**Synonyms:** Kill, Remove

**Antonyms:** Bear, Build

**Example Sentence:** The inhabitants of the country had been decimated

**8. SPECTACULAR (ADJECTIVE): (प्रभावशाली): Impressive**

**Synonyms:** Magnificent Splendid

**Antonyms:** Unimpressive

**Example Sentence:** The party suffered a spectacular loss in the election.

**9. ANXIETY (NOUN): (चिंता): Worry**

**Synonyms:** Concern, Apprehension

**Antonyms:** Calmness

**Example Sentence:** There was anxiety in her quiet voice.

**10. CREDULITY (NOUN): (भोलापन): Gullibility**

**Synonyms:** Naivety, Innocence

**Antonyms:** Worldliness

**Example Sentence:** Moneylenders prey upon their credulity and inexperience.
