1. PREVALENT (ADJECTIVE): (प्रचलित): Widespread
Synonyms: Prevailing, Frequent
Antonyms: Uncommon
Example Sentence: The ill practices are more prevalent in society today.
2. REVIEW (VERB): (पुनर्विचार करना): Reconsider
Synonyms: Re-examine, Reassess
Antonyms: Stick by
Example Sentence: All slides were then reviewed by one pathologist.
3. CONTEMPLATIVE (ADJECTIVE): (विचारशील): Thoughtful
Synonyms: Pensive, Reflective
Antonyms: Active
Example Sentence: She regarded me with a contemplative eye.
4. ADVERSARY (NOUN): (प्रतिद्वंद्वी): Opponent
Synonyms: Rival, Enemy
Antonyms: Ally
Example Sentence: Rita beat his old adversary in the quarter-finals.
5. SUCCUMB (VERB): (दबना): Yield
Synonyms: Give in, Give way
Antonyms: Resist
Example Sentence: We cannot merely give up and succumb to despair.
6. CRITICAL (ADJECTIVE): (जरूरी): Crucial

Synonyms: Vital, Essential
Antonyms: Unimportant
Example Sentence: Temperature is a critical factor in fruit storage.
7. FLAIR (NOUN): (कौशल): Aptitude
Synonyms: Talent, Gift
Antonyms: Inability
Example Sentence: She had a flair for certain languages.
8. DISCHARGE (VERB): (उतार देना): Unload
Synonyms: Offload, Empty
Antonyms: Load
Example Sentence: The ferry was discharging passengers.
9. STREAM (NOUN): (श्रृंखला): Succession
Synonyms: Series, String
Antonyms: Trickle
Example Sentence: A woman screamed a stream of abuse.
10. LIGHT-HEARTED (ADJECTIVE): (प्रसन्नचित): Carefree
Synonyms: Cheerful, Cheery
Antonyms: Miserable
Example Sentence: We had an excited, light-hearted chatter.
