**1. ZEALOUS (ADJECTIVE):** (उत्साही): Fervent

**Synonyms:** Ardent, Fervid

**Antonyms:** Apathetic

**Example Sentence:**The council was extremely zealous in the application of the regulations.

**2. GLORIFY (VERB):** (महिमामंडन करना): Ennoble

**Synonyms:** Exalt, Elevate

**Antonyms:** Dishonor

**Example Sentence:**A football video went viral glorifying violence.

**3. MARGINAL (ADJECTIVE):** (थोड़ा): Slight

**Synonyms:** Small, Tiny

**Antonyms:** Vast

**Example Sentence:**It seems likely to make only a marginal difference.

**4. ABATE (VERB):** (घटना): Subside

**Synonyms:** Lessen, Let up

**Antonyms:** Intensify

**Example Sentence:**In an hour or so the storm would abate and they could leave.

**5. QUIESCENT (ADJECTIVE):** (स्थिर): Inactive

**Synonyms:** Inert, Latent

**Antonyms:** Active

**Example Sentence:**Strikes were headed by groups of workers who had previously been quiescent.

**6. TIRESOME (ADJECTIVE):** (थकानेवाला): Boring

**Synonyms:** Dull, Tedious

**Antonyms:** Interesting

**Example Sentence:**Weeding is a tiresome but essential job.

**7. REINSTATE (VERB):** (पुनः स्थापित करना): Restore

**Synonyms:** Put back, Replace

**Antonyms:** Abolish

**Example Sentence:**The union threatened strike action if Owen was not reinstated.

**8. RIFE (ADJECTIVE):** (व्याप्त): Widespread

**Synonyms:** General Common

**Antonyms:** Scarce

**Example Sentence:**Male chauvinism was rife in medicine.

**9. CONSEQUENTIAL (ADJECTIVE):** (अहम): Resulting

**Synonyms:** Resultant, Ensuing

**Antonyms:** Casual

**Example Sentence:**A loss of confidence and a consequential withdrawal of funds.

**10. GLOSSY (ADJECTIVE):** (सतही आकर्षक): Expensive

**Synonyms:** High-quality, Stylish

**Antonyms:** Cheap

**Example Sentence:**That is just another glossy TV miniseries.
