1. . 1. NOTABLE (ADJECTIVE):
(उल्लेखनीय): Noteworthy

Synonyms: Remarkable, Outstanding

Antonyms: Insignificant

Example Sentence:The gardens are notable for their collection of magnolias and camellias.

2. IMPRUDENT (ADJECTIVE):
(अविवेकी): Unwise

Synonyms: Injudicious, Incautious

Antonyms: Prudent

Example Sentence:It would be imprudent to leave her winter coat behind.

3. INCURSION (NOUN): (चढ़ाई): Attack on

Synonyms: Assault on, Raid on

Antonyms: Retreat

Example Sentence:Soldiers went for incursions into enemy territory.

4. EXACERBATE (VERB): (खराब करना): Aggravate

Synonyms: Worsen, Inflamm

Antonyms: Calm

Example Sentence:The exorbitant cost of land in urban areas only exacerbated the problem.

5. CATASTROPHE (NOUN): (आपदा): Disaster

Synonyms: Calamity, Cataclysm

Antonyms: Salvation

Example Sentence:An environmental catastrophe has hit the country.

6. FORMIDABLE (ADJECTIVE): (डरावना): Intimidating

Synonyms: Forbidding, Redoubtable

Antonyms: Comforting

Example Sentence:Hers is a formidable opponent.

7. DIGNIFIED (ADJECTIVE): (प्रतिष्ठित): Stately

Synonyms: Noble, Courtly

Antonyms: Undignified

Example Sentence:She maintained a dignified silence.

8. PROFOUNDLY (ADVERB): (गंभीरतापूर्वक): Extremely

Synonyms: Very, Deeply

Antonyms: Superficially

Example Sentence:He profoundly altered the whole course of my life.

9. OPPRESSIVE (ADJECTIVE): (दमनकारी): Harsh

Synonyms: Cruel, Brutal

Antonyms: Lenient

Example Sentence:They survived an oppressive dictatorship.

10. IMPROBABLE (ADJECTIVE): (असंभाव्य): Unlikely

Synonyms: Not likely, Doubtful

Antonyms: Probably

Example Sentence:This account of events was seen by the jury as most improbable.
