<b>1. FEASIBLE (ADJECTIVE):</b> (व्यवहार्य): Practicable
<b>Synonyms:</b> Practical, Workable
<b>Antonyms:</b> Impractical
<b>Example Sentence:</b> It is not feasible to put most finds from excavations on public display.
<b>2. COMPROMISE(NOUN):(समझौता): Agreement</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> Understanding, Settlement
<b>Antonyms:</b> Intransigence
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Eventually they reached a compromise.
<b>3.FEDERAL(ADJECTIVE):(संयुक्त):Confederate</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> Federated, Combined
<b>Antonyms:</b> Unitary
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The health ministry has sole federal responsibility for healthcare.
<b>4.RETRIBUTION(NOUN):(प्रतिदण्ड): Punishment</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> Penalty, Nemesis
<b>Antonyms:</b> Forgiveness
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Employees asked not to be named, saying they feared retribution
<b>.5. VIABLE (ADJECTIVE):</b> (व्यवहार्य): Workable
<b>Synonyms:</b> Feasible, Practicable
<b>Antonyms:</b> Impracticable
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The proposed investment was said to be economically viable
<b>.6. INSURGENT (NOUN): (विद्रोही): Rebel</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> Revolutionary, Mutineer
<b>Antonyms:</b> Loyalist

<b>Example Sentence:</b> The armed insurgents planned an attack.
<b>7. DECIMATE (VERB): (बरबाद करना): Destroy</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> Kill, Remove
<b>Antonyms:</b> Bear, Build
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The inhabitants of the country had been decimated.
<b>8.SPECTACULAR(ADJECTIVE)(प्रभावशाली): Impressive</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> Magnificent Splendid
<b>Antonyms:</b> Unimpressive
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The party suffered a spectacular loss in the election.
<b>9. ANXIETY (NOUN): (चिंता): Worry</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> Concern, Apprehension
<b>Antonyms:</b> Calmness
<b>Example Sentence:</b> There was anxiety in her quiet voice.
<b>10. CREDULITY (NOUN): (भोलापन): Gullibility</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> Naivety, Innocence
<b>Antonyms:</b> Worldliness
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Moneylenders prey upon their credulity and inexperience.
