<b>1.DIRECTIVE (NOUN):(निदेशात्मक): instruction</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> direction, command
<b>Antonyms:</b> lawlessness
<b>Example Sentence:</b> A new EC directive has been forwarded for approval.
<b>2.CONSENSUS (NOUN): (सहमति): agreement</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> harmony, concord
<b>Antonyms:</b> disagreement
<b>Example Sentence:</b> There is a growing consensus that the current regime has failed.
<b>3.PALLIATIVE(ADJECTIVE):(पीड़ाहटानेवाला): soothing</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> alleviating sedative
<b>Antonyms:</b> intensifying
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Travel is like a palliative against depression for him.
<b>4.CONVALESCENT (ADJECTIVE): (अच्छा हो जानेवाला): recuperating</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> recovering improving
<b>Antonyms:</b> faltering
<b>Example Sentence:</b> He has always been a convalescent child.
<b>5. RESUMPTION (NOUN): (पुनरारंभ): restart</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> recommencement, reopening
<b>Antonyms:</b> suspension
<b>Example Sentence:</b> With peace came the resumption of foreign imports.
<b>6. EXTREMIST (NOUN): (अतिवादी): fanatic</b>

<b>Synonyms:</b> radical, zealot
<b>Antonyms:</b> moderate
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Right-wing extremists created trouble.
<b>7.SCEPTICISM (NOUN): (संदेहवाद): doubt</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> disbelief, distrust
<b>Antonyms:</b> conviction
<b>Example Sentence:</b> There was some scepticism in the claims
<b>.8.DISASTROUS(ADJECTIVE):(उत्पातक): catastrophic</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> calamitous, cataclysmic
<b>Antonyms:</b> fortunate
<b>Example Sentence:</b> A disastrous fire swept through the museum
<b>.9.DISCRIMINATION (NOUN):(भेदभाव): prejudice</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> bias, bigotry
<b>Antonyms:</b> impartiality
<b>Example Sentence:</b> They are victims of racial discrimination.
<b>10.CURB (VERB): (नियंत्रण करना): restrain</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> hold back, keep back
<b>Antonyms:</b> release
<b>Example Sentence:</b> She promised she would curb her temper.
