4.HERCULEAN (ADJECTIVE): (अत्यंत कठिन): arduous	10.ALIENATE (VERB): (विमुख करना): estrange
Synonyms: gruelling, laborious	Synonyms: turn away, set apart

Example Sentence: I have a herculean task in trying to paint an extraordinary picture in half an hour.	Example Sentence: Even where we least like him we find nothing mean to alienate him from us.
5.SPECULATIVE (ADJECTIVE): (जोखिमी): risky	
Synonyms: hazardous, unsafe	
Antonyms: safe	
Example Sentence: The bonuses cannot be put at risk due to some speculative investment.	
6.THWART (VERB): (विफल करना): foil	
Synonyms: frustrate, balk	
Antonyms: assist	
Example Sentence: She did all she could to thwart his plans.
