<b>1. ESCALATION (NOUN): (वृद्धि): Rise</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> Hike, Advance
<b>Antonyms:</b> Plunge
<b>Example Sentence:</b> A further escalation of the crisis now seems inevitable.
<b>2. COMPLACENT (ADJECTIVE): (आत्मसंतुष्ट): Smug</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> Self-satisfied, Self-approving
<b>Antonyms:</b> Dissatisfied
<b>Example Sentence:</b> You can't afford to be complacent about security.
<b>3. WRANGLE (NOUN): (तकरार): Argument</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> Dispute, Disagreement
<b>Antonyms:</b> Agreement
<b>Example Sentence:</b> An insurance wrangle is holding up compensation payments.
<b>4. INCLUSIVE (ADJECTIVE): (समावेशी): All-in</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> All-inclusive Comprehensive
<b>Antonyms:</b> Exclusive
<b>Example Sentence:</b> They have menus stating fully inclusive prices
<b>5. IMPLICIT (ADJECTIVE): (अंतर्निहित): Implied</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> Indirect, Inferred
<b>Antonyms:</b> Explicit
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Comments seen as implicit criticism of the policies.
<b>6. COLLISION (NOUN): (टकराव): Clash</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> Conflict, Opposition
<b>Antonyms:</b> Coalescence

**Example Sentence:**When she married an NRI, collision of two diverse cultures took place.

**7. EFFICACIOUS (ADJECTIVE): (प्रभावोत्पादक): Effective**

**Synonyms:** Successful, Effectual

**Antonyms:** Inefficacious

**Example Sentence:**The treatment was efficacious in some cases

**8. OFFENSIVE (ADJECTIVE): (आपत्तिजनक): Insulting**

**Synonyms:** Rude, Derogatory

**Antonyms:** Complimentary

**Example Sentence:**The allegations made are deeply offensive to us.

**9. ABRIDGE (VERB): (संक्षेप करना): Shorten**

**Synonyms:** Cut, Curtail

**Antonyms:** Lengthen

**Example Sentence:**It was abridged from the original work.

**10. TANGIBLE (ADJECTIVE): (वास्तविक): Real**

**Synonyms:** Actual, Solid

**Antonyms:** Abstract

**Example Sentence:**The emphasis is now on tangible results.
