| <b>Synonyms:</b> get to grips with, address   |
| <b>Antonyms:</b> avoid  |
| <b>Example Sentence:</b> The best thing you can do in an embarrassing situation is to confront it.    |
| <b>2.RIFE (ADJECTIVE): (फैला हुआ): widespread</b>   |
| <b>Synonyms:</b> general, common  |
| <b>Antonyms:</b> scarce, unknown  |
| <b>Example Sentence:</b> Male chauvinism was rife in medicine.  |
| <b>3.EXACERBATE (VERB): (बदतर होना): aggravate</b>  |
| <b>Synonyms:</b> worsen, inflame  |
| <b>Antonyms:</b> calm   |
| <b>Example Sentence:</b> Their silly attempts to resolve their misunderstandings exacerbated matters. |
| <b>4.POISED (ADJECTIVE): (शांतचित्त): self-possessed</b>  |
| <b>Synonyms:</b> self-assured, composed   |
| <b>Antonyms:</b> excited  |
| <b>Example Sentence:</b> Not every day you saw that poised, competent kid distressed.                 |
| <b>5.PURSUE (VERB): (संचालित करना): conduct</b>   |
| <b>Synonyms:</b> undertake, follow  |
| <b>Antonyms:</b> give up  |
| <b>Example Sentence:</b> We shall not pursue the matter any further.                                  |

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| <b>6.FERVENT (ADJECTIVE): (उत्कट): impassioned</b>  |
| <b>Synonyms:</b> passionate, intense  |
| <b>Antonyms:</b> apathetic  |
| <b>Example Sentence:</b> I am a fervent supporter of the revolution.                        |
| <b>7.MARGINAL (ADJECTIVE): (थोड़ा): slight</b>  |
| <b>Synonyms:</b> small, tiny  |
| <b>Antonyms:</b> vast   |
| <b>Example Sentence:</b> It seems to make just marginal difference.                         |
| <b>8.WHITTLE (VERB): (काटना): erode</b>   |
| <b>Synonyms:</b> wear away, eat away  |
| <b>Antonyms:</b> increase   |
| <b>Example Sentence:</b> The list of five was whittled down to two.                         |
| <b>9.RADICAL (ADJECTIVE): (पूर्ण): thorough</b>   |
| <b>Synonyms:</b> thoroughgoing, complete  |
| <b>Antonyms:</b> superficial  |
| <b>Example Sentence:</b> A radical overhaul of the existing regulatory framework is needed. |
| <b>10.MOUNT (VERB): (चढ़ना): go up</b>  |
| <b>Synonyms:</b> ascend, climb  |
| <b>Antonyms:</b> descend  |
| <b>Example Sentence:</b> He mounted the steps.  |
