<b>.1 CONFRONT (VERB): (मुकाबला करना): tackle</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> get to grips with, address
<b>Antonyms:</b> avoid
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The best thing you can do in an embarrassing situation is to confront it
<b>.2.RIFE (ADJECTIVE): (फैला हुआ): widespread</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> general, common
<b>Antonyms:</b> scarce, unknown
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Male chauvinism was rife in medicine.
<b>3.EXACERBATE(VERB):(बदतरहोना): aggrate</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> worsen, inflame
<b>Antonyms:</b> calm
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Their silly attempts to resolve their misunderstandings exacerbated matters.
<b>4.POISED (ADJECTIVE): (शांतचित्त): self-possessed</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> self-assured, composed
<b>Antonyms:</b> excited
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Not every day you saw that poised, competent kid distressed
<b>.5.PURSUE (VERB): (संचालित करना): conduct</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> undertake, follow
<b>Antonyms:</b> give up
<b>Example Sentence:</b> We shall not pursue the matter any further.
<b>6. FAIRLY (ADVERB): (युक्तिपूर्वक): reasonably</b>

<b>Synonyms:</b> passably, satisfactorily
<b>Antonyms:</b> insufficiently
<b>Example Sentence:</b> I was fairly certain she had nothing to do with the affair
<b>.7.MENACE (VERB): (खतरे में डालना): threaten</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> jeopardize, imperil
<b>Antonyms:</b> friendly
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Africa's elephants are still menaced by poaching
<b>.8.DREADFUL (ADJECTIVE): (भयानक): terrible</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> frightful, horrible
<b>Antonyms:</b> mild
<b>Example Sentence:</b> He survived a dreadful accident.
<b>9. PSYCHE (NOUN): (मानस): soul</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> spirit, life force
<b>Antonyms:</b> body
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Her work touches something profound in the human psyche.
<b>10.SPORADIC(ADJECTIVE):(छिटपुट): occasional</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> infrequent, irregular
<b>Antonyms:</b> frequent
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Sporadic fighting broke out.
